

Consolidated text of the decision

WARSAW UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY

**Decision no. 185 /2015
of the Warsaw University of Technology Rector
of 10 December 2015**

**on fees payable by foreigners who undertake study and other forms of education at
Warsaw University of Technology**

Pursuant to § 17 of the regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 12 October 2006 on undertaking and pursuing study and trainings by foreigners and their participation in research and development work (Journal of Laws no. 190, item 1406 with further amendments), it is hereby determined as follows:

§ 1

1. The following semester tuition fees (in Euro) payable by foreigners pursuing degree programmes as fee-paying students are hereby determined:

2. The fees specified in section 1 apply to the nominal study plan, with 30 ECTS points per semester.
3. If the study programme for the student in a given academic year covers a different number of ECTS points in the semester than 30, the fee for a semester of study is determined proportionally to the number of ECTS points, i.e. it is determined with the following formula:

$$k_s = \frac{k_n}{30 \text{ ECTS}} \cdot n \text{ ECTS}$$

where:

- k_s – total fee for a semester of study for the student
- k_n – nominal fee (30 ECTS points per semester)
- 30 ECTS – nominal number of ECTS points per semester
- $n \text{ ECTS}$ – number of ECTS points for all courses completed by the student in the semester he/she is registered on, from previous and subsequent semesters, and make-up courses determined by the Dean of the Faculty,

subject to provisions of section 3a.

3a. The fees for consultations on the diploma thesis for students retaking the last semesters of degree programmes are:

- 1) in first-cycle study PLN 200 (lump sum);
 - 2) in second-cycle study PLN 360 (lump sum).
4. The fee for post-graduate study at the Business School is determined to be EUR 15 900 for the two-year extra-mural Executive MBA programme.

§ 2

1. In economically justified situations, especially when there are greater numbers of foreign candidates to degree programmes, the dean of the faculty, director of the college, director of the Business School may apply to the Rector to determine a lower semester fee (in Euro) than the amount specified in § 1 section 1 and section 4 in a given academic year.
2. A non-returnable fee for admissions proceedings to first- and second-cycle study, and doctoral study is EUR 200.

§ 3

Decision no. 94/2014 of the WUT Rector of 14 July 2014 on tuition fees payable by foreigners who undertake degree programmes and other forms of education at Warsaw University of Technology expires.

§ 4

Foreigners admitted to degree programmes and trainings or admitted in order to participate in research and development work at WUT before 22 August 2015, shall pay tuition fees in accordance with the regulations and to the amounts determined in hitherto regulations until they graduate from study or doctoral study or complete research and development work.

§ 5

The decision enters into force upon its signing.
