

**WARSAW UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY**

**Regulation No. 173/2020**

**of the Warsaw University of Technology Rector**

**of 22 December 2020**

**on the procedures for the winter examination period in the academic year 2020/2021.**

Pursuant to Article 23 section 1 and 76a of the Act of 20 July 2018 Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Acts of 2020, item 85, as amended), it is resolved as follows:

§ 1

1. The winter examination period in the academic year 2020/2021 shall be conducted remotely, using electronic communication tools.
2. Upon the request of the head of the basic or university-wide organisational unit which conducts teaching, evaluated by the Team for coordination of prevention measures at the Warsaw University of Technology related to potential risk of Covid-19 infection, the Rector may consent to conducting in-person examinations in justified situations.

§ 2

1. Should course regulations referred to in § 11 section 2 of the WUT Academic Regulations need to be amended due to the remote mode of conducting examinations in the examination period, course leaders shall update them. Course regulations may be amended pursuant to § 11 section 4 of the WUT Academic Regulations.
2. Pursuant to § 8 section 1 of the WUT Academic Regulations, the head of the basic or university-wide organisational unit shall inform of the mode of conducting examinations, i.e.:
  - 1) decide on the remote mode and determine the IT tools used to conduct the examination, or
  - 2) decide on the in-person mode in accordance with the consent referred to in § 1 section 2.

§ 3

Verification of the achieved learning outcomes should be conducted pursuant to the regulations laid down in Regulation no. 100/2020 of the WUT Rector of 29 September 2020 on the rules on the verification of achieving learning outcomes for first-cycle and second-cycle studies and long-cycle master's studies in remote learning.

§ 4

The regulation enters into force upon signing.
